POSITION DESCRIPTION:

This position is part of the National Generation 2032 Coach Program (Gen32), which is a 2 year program with the purpose to develop the capabilities and maximise potential of Australia's emerging high performance coaches to thrive as people, leaders and enablers of performance. The vision of Gen32 is to contribute to the depth and diversity of the Australian high performance coaching pool and build support networks for coaches to win well and inspire success.

Successful Coaches will be afforded bespoke learning opportunities along with access to targeted personal development in line with opportunities identified through their individual coach development plans. 20 salaried positions offered. AIS will finalise selections for these positions in consultation with NSO's and NIN.

All coaches in the program will experience:

- Full or part-time employment by the NSO or NIN partner for two years (co-funded by the AIS).
- Immersion into the DPE of a HP program and integration into a HP coaching team.
- Coaching HP athletes, with the guidance of a technical lead.
- Peer learning from coaches of other sports within the program.
- Exposure to other HP environments and personnel.
- Access to ICDP, International Travel and Parental Support funding

REQUIREMENTS:

- A Progression Surf Coach qualification (formerly Level 2) is required with active credentials (First Aid, CPR, Ocean Safety, Working with Children).
- A 2-year commitment would be required with the position commencing in January 2025.
- Attend AIS led Learning Labs (6 across the 2 years, face-to-face) delivered by AIS
- Attend Community of Practice sessions (monthly, virtual)
- Developing and implementing an Individual Coach Development Plan (ICDP)
