National Integrity Framework



The National Integrity Framework (NIF) has been adopted by Surfing Australia to provide surfing with a system to proactively mitigate integrity threats, which in turn provides a safe, fair and inclusive environment for participants and staff at all levels of surfing.

This framework has been implemented to ensure a safe and fun, environment for everyone involved in surfing, from learning to surfers and coaches, all the way through to our Olympians, and everyone in between.

Surfing Australia's Framework is made up of 6 policies:

- 1. National Integrity Framework
- 2. <u>Member Protection Policy</u>
- 3. Child Safeguarding Policy
- 4. <u>Competition Manipulation & Sport Wagering Policy</u>
- 5. Improper Use of Drugs & Medicine Policy
- 6. <u>Complaints, Disputes & Discipline Policy</u>

As surf schools the most important and relevant policies for you are the Child Safeguarding & Member Protection Policy, which not only is there to ensure the protection & safety of children, but also your staff and business from potential threats.

As coaches and business owners it is your responsibility to understand your rights and obligations and abide by the policies set out under the NIF. These policies are there to offer surfing and everyone involved a streamlined approach to tackling possible threats and a clear and independent process for managing potential breaches of integrity policies.

Sporting Schools is a \$400 million Australian Government initiative designed to help schools increase children's participation in sport and connect them with community sport opportunities. Surfing Australia offers four Sporting Schools programs, delivered by Surfing Australia-affiliated schools.

Sporting Schools funds have to be used through a National Sporting Organisation, and only schools affiliated with Surfing Australia can access this program!

Your school could access between \$1,000 - \$3,000 to run a Sporting Schools program with your local schools.

Coach Ready Program 2024

Surfing Australia is stoked to announce the return of the Coach Ready Program in 2024! Thanks to Macquarie Sports, we will once again aim to equip 20 new coaches, aged 16-20 years, with the skills to become certified Surf Coaches, with the ultimate goal of them securing employment at a local surf school.

During a week-long camp (from Monday, July 16th, to Friday, July 19th, 2024), at Surfing Australia's High-Performance Centre in Casuarina, NSW, participants will undergo comprehensive training. This training includes a foundation surf coaching course, first aid certification, CPR training, and a surf rescue certificate, along with expert knowledge for Surfing Australia's high-performance coaches.

Surf schools are currently experiencing high demand for qualified surf coaches, making this program an excellent opportunity for graduates to seamlessly transition into employment. We will open applications in February 2024, and we encourage you to nominate coaches from your local community.

Surfers Rescue 24/7

Surfers Rescue 24/7 is a free board rescue and CPR course for all surfers and recreational water users in NSW. It provides crucial training to assist in an emergency situation and could ultimately save a life.

The Concept:

Surfing NSW, with support of the NSW Government, are giving all surfers in NSW the opportunity to do a free CPR and Board Rescue Course – "Surfers Rescue 24/7".

Surfing has been part of the Australian society since the late 50's and during this time, recreational surfers from all walks of life have been instrumental in helping to keep our beaches safe.

Be it a patrolled or unpatrolled beach across NSW, Surfers are on the beach from dawn to dusk, 365 days a year. A lot of them are responsible for hundreds of thousands of unsung rescues.

Surfing NSW is rolling out free Surfers Rescue 24/7 & CPR courses for Surf Schools, boardrider clubs and surf communities all over the state.

PERFORMANCE COACH

Schools are categorised in GOLD Class if their school's:

 Primary market is captured in, or within a 50km radius of one of Australia's 10 metropolitan districts* Schools are categorised as SILVER if their school's:

 Primary market is captured more than 50km away from one of Australia's metropolitan districts* Schools are categorised as BRONZE if ALL of the following conditions apply to their school:

- School operates on a parttime basis
- A maximum of 1 staff member is employed/ contracted by the school

Performance Coaches are individual coaches who meet the following conditions:

- Operate as a sole coach
- Hold an active Progression Surf Coach accreditation
- Maximum coach: athlete ratio of 1:6
- Must coach only advanced level surfers

FNULTIPLE LICENCES



- Accredited schools pay a licensing fee for each unique district (Local Government Area) of operation.
- Performance coaches are exempt from this, as they are not required to have a Council Permit.
- Multiple operations within a single LGA will be covered under a single license, however operations spread across multiple districts will require a respective number of licenses.
- Multiple licenses will earn a discounted rate.
- Affiliated schools must license all districts of operation with their business.

Discounts only apply to schools when multiple licenses are required within the same State and School Class
